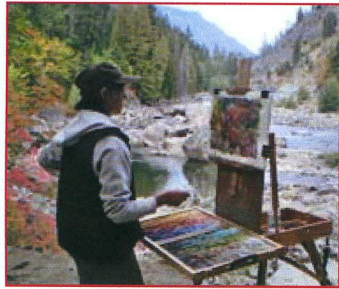


Plein Air Pastel Painting Workshop in Maine



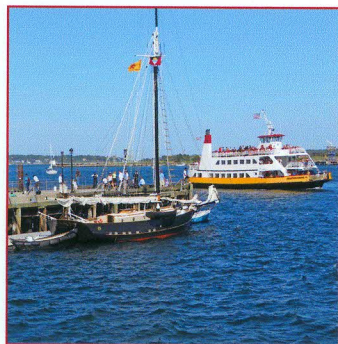

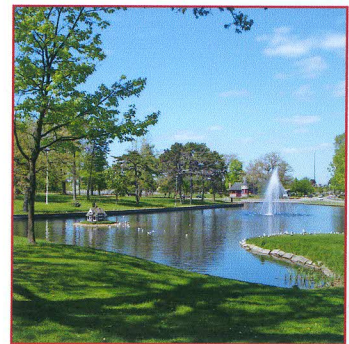


Portland, Cityscape
